

## Racine/Southern Alumni Association Scholarship Fund

Today's college students often face overwhelming financial barriers that make it difficult to afford college expenses:

- Books can often cost \$100 or more each, with students being required to pay hundreds of dollars each school term for the required texts.
- Tuition/room/board at local colleges and universities are at an all-time high:
  - University of Rio Grande--\$25,000 per year
  - Marietta College--\$34,000 per year
  - Ohio University--\$18,300 per year
- As grants decrease—which students are not required to pay back—students are increasingly required to take out student loans. Some of these loans accrue interest while the student is attending college. Students are then required to begin paying back loans after graduation.

These scholarships are much needed and welcomed by students and parents facing the challenges of paying for college along with other family expenses.
